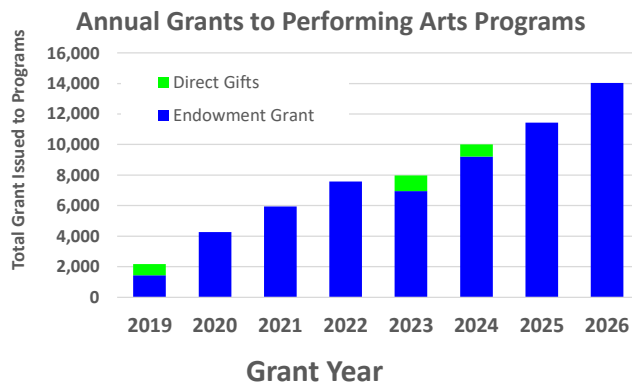

The Philomath Performing Arts Benefit Fund (PPABF) is building an endowment to provide incremental, perpetual financial support to the performing arts in the Philomath schools to maintain strong, enriching programs for the students and families in our community.

Grants Issued to Date

We first started raising money in 2017 and have been giving out grants to the performing arts programs in Philomath for the last eight years, totaling over \$59,500.



Here is a partial list of what the PPABF has been able to fund through our endowment grants:

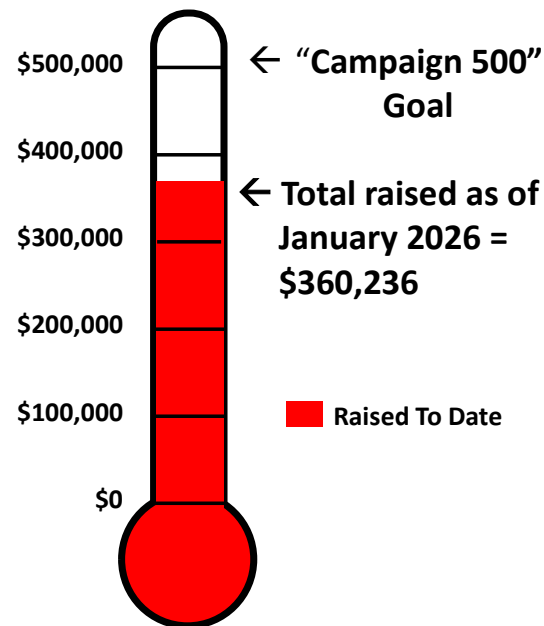
- ♪ *New instruments: piccolos, bells, base drum, recorders, keyboards, ukuleles, baritone sax, guitars, euphonium, etc.*
- ♪ *Numerous instrument repairs*
- ♪ *Risers, railings, chairs, and music stands*
- ♪ *Set materials for the theater program*
- ♪ *Sheet music and music supplies*



Campaign 500

In 2024, the PPABF Board launched “Campaign 500” — our focused effort to reach \$500,000 in our endowment fund by 2027. With that amount of capital, the Board could grant up to \$20,000 to the performing arts programs each year, every year, forever. As of January 2026, we have over \$360,000 toward that goal.
